Purpose of the Position

Planning, food preparation, serving, cleaning and essential aspects of making events successful.

Responsibilities and Duties

- Planning
 - Communicate with the event organizers to understand the goals and requirements of the event.
 - Make a checklist of tasks that need to be accomplished before, during and after the event.
- Food Prep
 - Coordinate with the kitchen or cooking team to ensure you have a clear understanding of the menu.
 - Help with chopping, peeling, and any other food preparation tasks.
 - o Ensure that you follow any dietary restrictions or preference of attendees.
- Serving
 - Work with the cleaning team to keep the venue tidy during and after the event.
 - o Dispose of waste properly and ensure that the venue is left in good condition.
- Group Work
 - o Communication and collaborate effectively with other volunteers.
 - o Be open to taking on different roles as needed and support each other.

Qualifications

- Willingness to serve and collaborate with others.
- Communicate availability to coordinator(s).

Commitment Expected

- Crews are needed for:
 - Regular Functions: Congregational meals (Easter Breakfast, Church Picnic, Thanksgiving Service, etc.), Food From the Heart, and Lunch with the Pastors.
 - When food is provided during special church events.
- Expected Commitment is to be available for two or more functions annually.

Training

• New volunteers will have the opportunity to shadow a seasoned kitchen worker and learn all the appropriate procedures and policies related to the kitchen and serving food at LPC.
