

Everything You Need to Know

Welcome to Adventure Camp! Your kids are about to embark on what we consider one of the most important events in their lives. I say that because camp changed my life! It wasn't just the fun, or the teaching, or the challenges... it was the combination of AWESOME leaders SHOWING me how to live for God and the change of environment where living for God was actually the COOL thing to do! That started something inside me that has never gone away... the movement of the Holy Spirit!

It is our prayer that your child experiences that same chance... to see real people living out their faith, and to have a chance to do the same!

CHECK-IN & LOCATION INFORMATION:

Check in for Adventure Camp is on **Thursday (7/31) at 4:00 pm** @ Pendleton Christian Church (PCC) (If for some reason your child will be late, you need to contact **Katrina@pcc.life** and let her know.)

Please make sure to fill out your Medical and Code of Conduct Forms - **USING YOUR CAMPER'S INFORMATION**. These forms were attached to your registration process. If you are missing these forms we will be sending email reminders so that you can have them completed before check-in. This will speed up your check-in process.

Your kids will always be at one of two locations:

PCC (1170 S. Pendleton Ave.)

DeShong property - 9182 S. 300 W, Pendleton (right off 300 W, which is Angle Road extended south)

Our daily schedule will begin out at the campsite. We are there until after lunch. Each afternoon we will be at the church until right before dinner. Each evening (by 7:00 pm) we will be back out at the campsite. An exact camper schedule will be available on Thursday, July 1st.

EMERGENCY CONTACT NUMBERS:

If during the event you need to get a hold of us for ANY REASON you will need to contact **Katrina Schnepp (765)-617-5462.**

END OF CAMP:

Parents should come to PCC at **8:30 pm** on Sunday **(8/3)** to pick up their student following the final session.

MEDICATIONS:

We will have Medical Staff at the entire event. If your child has medications that need to be administered, the medications must be in the original container from the pharmacy with the child's name on it. Then place them in a zip-lock plastic bag **WITH THE CHILD'S NAME WRITTEN ON IT AND YOUR CONTACT NUMBER! ALL MEDICATIONS** (even over the counter medications) **MUST BE TURNED IN TO THE MEDICAL STAFF AT CHECK-IN**.

PERSONAL BELONGINGS:

- Please read FULLY the "What to bring" page. ALL ITEMS should be marked with your camper's name if at all possible. Camp chairs, towels, clothes, etc. should be marked!
- NO ELECTRONICS... PLEASE... do a pat down of your child if you have to. We simply want them to disconnect from the crazy world... and connect to God!
- Please make sure you double check the **SPECIAL ITEMS** to bring this year these items are things that we are asking you to provide that will make your child's experience at camp extra special this year.

Baptisms

Every year we offer campers and staff the opportunity to publicly confess and demonstrate their decision to follow Jesus through baptism. We love baptisms at camp and think it's a great thing for everyone to see and celebrate.

In an effort to be prepared we wanted to let you know that this year **we will be doing Baptisms at 9:15 on Sunday MORNING (August 3rd).** Anyone who would like to come watch and celebrate with us is welcome. Baptisms are held in the pool at the camp site.

What to Bring:

HOW TO PACK:

Every Camper and Group Leader MUST use one of the waterproof storage bags found at the QR code provided. We have found these bags to be the best way to keep everyone's items dry and organized. **No other storage method will be accepted,** so make sure you order your bag and label it with your child's name.



CLOTHING LIST: (mark with child's name please)

- 2 pairs of shorts
- 3 short-sleeved tops (will be given camp t-shirt that is washed daily)
- 1 pair of long pants
- 1 long-sleeved shirt or sweatshirt
- Sleepwear
- 4 sets of underwear
- Swimsuit
- 3 pairs of athletic socks
- Shower shoes or flip flops
- 1 pair of athletic shoes to wear daily (these will get dirty)
- 1 light rain jacket
- Hat for sun protection (optional)
- This year our "last supper" at Camp will be "NEON NIGHTS so pack something fun to wear as we celebrate Adventure Camp 2025.



SLEEPING GEAR & TOWELS

- One sleeping bag
- Pillow (if desired, none are provided)
- Towel (mark w/ name please)

PERSONAL ITEMS:

- Bible (MUST BRING)
- Toiletries-hairbrush, comb, toothpaste, toothbrush, deodorant, soap, shampoo, sunscreen, etc.
- Sunglasses (if desired)
- Bug spray (essential)
- Flashlight with NEW batteries
- Medication (will be collected and administered by camp nurse, unless otherwise notified by parents)
- CAMP CHAIR (mark w/ name on duct tape please)
- A water bottle with a LARGE OPENING (with campers full name written somewhere)
- Individual Gatorade mix packets (we will only be providing high quality H²0)
- Personal Hand Sanitizer (to use at your discretion)

SPECIAL ITEMS for ADVENTURE CAMP 2025:

*have these items separate from your camp stuff and ready when you check in
