Select a verse to meditate on, reflect on its meaning, and let its truth shape your mindset today.

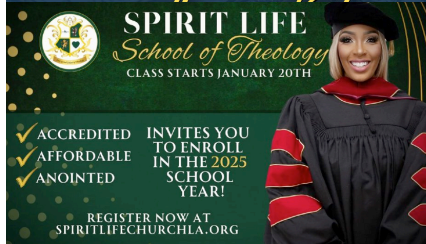
