Chime in without raising your hand and you're interrupting. Ask with a snicker or sneer and you're off to the principal's office.


People don't always welcome questions. But Jesus does.




Fold a box. When you get home


...write out questions for God on scraps of paper, and put them in the box. Let your family add questions, and then share them all.

Here's how:


- Fold letter-size paper in half as shown.
- **2** Fold in half again the other way.
- **3** Unfold. Then pinch the top left corner of the rectangle and fold it inward to the center and make a triangle.









- 4 Flip over and repeat on the other side so it looks like this.
- **5** Fold the top triangle flap to the right so it looks like this. Flip and repeat on the other side.
- **6** Fold side of top flap to the center, then fold the top flap of the other side into the center.
- Flip it over and fold those flaps to the center, too.











8 Fold the bottom flap up on side one.



Flip it over and fold the bottom flap on side two.



Flip it upside down and open it up. Push center point to flatten the bottom. Voila—a box!
