In our *Be Bold!* curriculum, the class delved into a thought-provoking question: *Does God expect me to pray in public?*

This week, our 10-12 age group explored how God is always with you (*Hebrews 13:5*). We explored the following versus to help guide our discussions: *1 Thessalonians 5:17-18*, Mark 1:35, Matthew 14:23, Matthew 6:5-6, Luke 10:21, Luke 23:34 and John 11:41-42. "f you were raised in a Christian home, you may have inherited some "rules" regarding prayer: You have to pray before meals (well, not breakfast, but other meals), you must say, "In Jesus' name" forthe prayer to count, and you aren't required to pray in restaurants like you



are at home. Today you and your preteens will explore what the Bible says and doesn't say about prayer. Prepare to make some discoveries!"
