A Journey Along the Silk Road

The Silk Road... It sounds like a smooth pathway, doesn't it? The luxurious texture of silk has made it a highly desirable material for centuries. Luxury goods such as silk flowed along this extensive network of caravan routes that connected East Asia to the Middle East, Europe, and Africa for more than 1500 years, beginning around 130 B.C. In addition to exotic products, cultural and religious ideas were also transmitted by those who traveled this path.

For those who spread the hope of Jesus, the Silk Road has not been a smooth and silky path to travel on. While the physical terrain is often rocky and mountainous, the spiritual landscape has been even more harsh. However, as the prophet Isaiah foretold, the Lord prepares a way in the wilderness, making rough ground level and rugged places a plain (Is. 40:3-5). In fact, Isaiah's prophecy found its fulfillment in the coming of the Messiah, Jesus Christ, as John the Baptist prepared a way in the wilderness for His arrival.

Today God is still making a way for His love in the wilderness, and he graciously invites us to join Him on this journey. How? For some, it means serving Him by traveling to the Silk Road to learn the language of the people and share the love of Jesus with them. For others, it means praying for and financially supporting those who are going. One of our 2025-2026 Prayer and Action Goals is to "take practical steps to help raise up the next generation of Global Ministry Partners who will abide in Christ as they go into the world." What steps will you take this year? He is calling each of us to do our part in making a way for His love to reach the Silk Road people. It starts with abiding in Christ and taking the next step in following Him.
