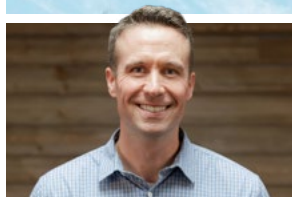

Our next day of Prayer and Fasting will be **Wednesday, August 6**. On that day, we invite you to join us as a church in skipping one or more meals and focusing that time on prayer. This month, we're inviting you to join us in praying together at our annual Churchwide Day of Prayer.

Five college students once visited London to hear the powerful preaching of Charles Spurgeon at The Metropolitan Tabernacle. They arrived early and were met by a gentleman who offered to give them a tour. He suggested they go see the furnace room in the basement. It was a hot July day and the students were not interested. Not wanting to appear rude, they consented. Their guide quietly opened the door and there in the basement of the church were several hundred people fervently praying for the service that was about to begin. It was then that their guide introduced himself. He was none other than Charles Spurgeon himself. He wanted these college students to understand that prayer was the power source of his ministry. Prayer is also the power source of our ministry as a church. OUR YEAR OF ABIDING | We don't use the term "abide" much anymore but in John 15 Jesus tells us to abide in him. Abiding in Jesus means being deeply connected to Him, like a branch is connected to a vine. Abiding is how we live out our union with Jesus on a daily basis. This is important because it's how we bear fruit in our lives. God created you to bear fruit. He created you to do good works and to grow in godly character in ways that reflect his life and goodness. Apart from Jesus, our lives will lack fruit, and worse yet, they will produce thorns. Please join us in kicking off this ministry year of abiding by reading through the Prayer & Action Goal brochure and asking for God's guidance and help as we pursue these goals together.

WORD: Go deeper into my union with Christ by hearing and studying the second half of the Gospel of John (Chpts 11-21).

WORSHIP: Experience more peace when feeling anxious or fearful by abiding in God's Word.

EQUIP: Transform my schedule so that my daily routines of work and rest better reflect the work and rest of the Savior I abide in.

ENGAGE-LOCAL: Abide in Jesus so that my love for God will flow into the everyday interactions I have with the people that he puts in my path.

ENGAGE-GLOBAL: Take practical steps to help raise up the next generation of Global Ministry Partners who will abide in Christ as they go into the world.
