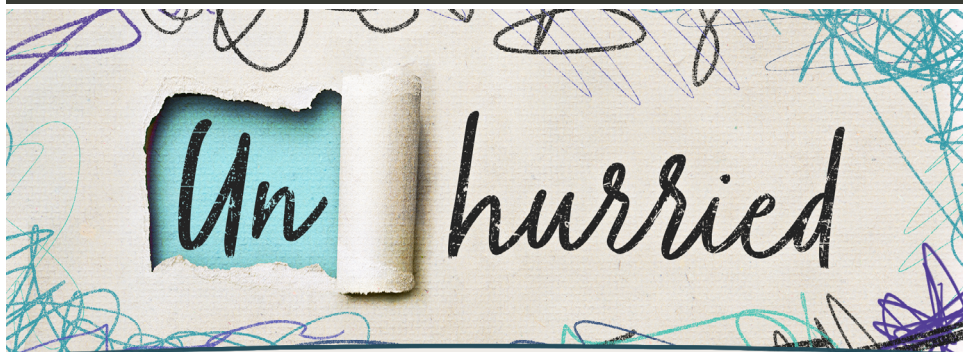

WORD: Go deeper into my union with Christ by hearing and studying the second half of the Gospel of John (Chpts 11-21).
