DAY OF PRAYER & FASTING - WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 3

Our next day of Prayer and Fasting will be Wednesday, September 3. On that day, we invite you to join us as a church in skipping one or more meals and focusing that time on prayer. If you are unable to skip a meal for health reasons, try fasting from something else (television, social media, etc.).

"Back to School" time is a season filled with varying emotions including excitement and anticipation for the new beginnings and rhythms ahead for the fall. There can be apprehension and fear of the unknown ahead. This is a season filled with many transitions. By God's grace, these transitions will push us toward dependence on God! Deut. 31:8 says, "It is the Lord who goes before you. He will be with you; he will not leave you or forsake you. Do not fear or be dismayed." The Lord goes before us and is with us in these transitions. Please join us in praying for children who are transitioning into a new school year - pray they would understand their need for Jesus in this transition and depend on Him. Pray for parents to support their children well and model a dependence upon Jesus to their children in the midst of change. Pray for teachers as they adjust to a new group of students. Pray for discernment, energy, and grace as they navigate how to best love and equip the students God has entrusted them with. Lastly, pray our church family would come alongside and support one another in this time. May we consider one another needs more significant than our own. Reach out to educators, parents, and those in the midst of "Back to School" transitions for ways to specifically pray.

OUR YEAR OF ABIDING: We don't use the term "abide" much anymore but in John 15 Jesus tells us to abide in him. Abiding in Jesus means being deeply connected to Him, like a branch is connected to a vine. Abiding is how we live out our union with Jesus on a daily basis. This is important because it's how we bear fruit in our lives. God created you to bear fruit. He created you to do good works and to grow in godly character in ways that reflect his life and goodness. Apart from Jesus, our lives will lack fruit, and worse yet, they will produce thorns. Please join us in kicking off this ministry year of abiding by reading through the Prayer & Action Goal brochure and asking for God's guidance and help as we pursue these goals together.
