2nd Grade swim lessons at the YMCA. Many thanks to the Y for supporting this program! Upcoming Dates: Nov. 7th, 14th & 21st







We need judges for this event. Please contact the school office and volunteer to be a judge of these great projects.


Please Plan to stop by and check the projects out, enjoy some soup and shop the Book Fair.


