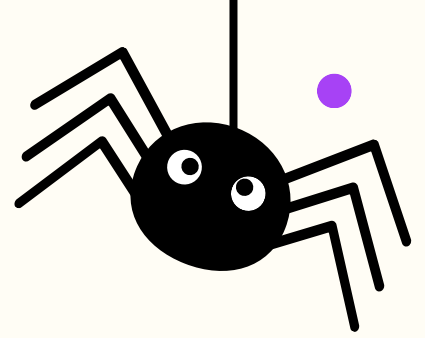
## No-School/Faculty Funeral
