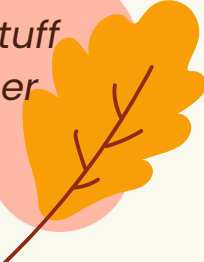


## Chapel Offering for November/December

Grades K-5 will be singing in church This Sunday, November 9<sup>th</sup> @ 9:00 a.m. service at St. Paul's Lutheran Church.



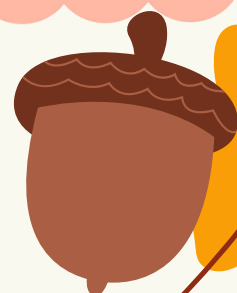
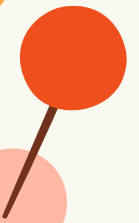
## Science Fair / PTL Soup Supper
