FINANCIAL PICTURE UPDATE

We are pleased to report that as of the end of June our income/spending over against our expenses is about even. All our bills are paid, and we are presently paying 8% of our apportionments, which is below the requested amount of 14% of our monthly income received.

One of the contributing factors to this good news is that the Dakotas Annual Conference has committed to support our church by paying Pastor Bob's salary. This support helps the overall budget during this interim time. There are three other positive items to share. First, we do have emergency funds of approximately \$109,000 which can assist us over the next six months and beyond. In addition, we have restricted funds which can help us meet some of our program costs over that same period of time. Lastly, we have been able to save on some expenses in some other areas, which has been helpful.

This summer our church program ministry has continued. We had a wonderful experience at Vacation Bible School in June! Our youth and children ministries have held a variety of summer events to enhance spiritual growth and just plain having fun. You're giving to God through the church makes a huge difference!

My friends, our God is a generous and faithful God! We seek to be generous as God is generous with us. Know our thanks and gratitude for your faithful giving to God through our church! Thank you.

We are in the process of seeking members and friends of our church to serve on the Leadership Council, as well as creating teams in all of our program areas in the church.
