FINANCIAL NEWS

When I arrived as your interim pastor one of the main concerns was going to be our future finances following our disaffiliation vote. Our Leadership Team/Finance team is pleased to report that we have come to December with a solid cash flow and even with anticipating a significant shortfall we have been able to meet all our financial obligations. We still need a strong giving in December to meet our final goals. Traditionally, December is a strong month of giving to God through the church and we are so grateful for the faithfulness of God's people. Many have given above and beyond during this time frame. Thank you for your faithful giving to God!

As we move into 2024 we approved a \$507,000 budget at our Annual Charge Conference. We will still need to use some reserve funds to fully meet this budget thus we need your help. Last week we mailed out an estimate for the card for 2024. Please prayerfully consider your giving to God through our church for next year. Then, we thank you in advance, for returning your card back will help us in finalizing our income needs for 2024. Thank you for making the effort to help us achieve our ministry goals for 2024. We give God thanks for all God's love and joy in our giving back to God!

HOPE CENTER TO CEASE OPERATIONS

Rapid City First UMC has been in conversation with the Hope Center Board over the last few months concerning the present lease and renewal of the lease. Presently, the ministry of the Hope Center Building is facing overwhelming numbers and inadequate space. We had been glad for their progress to find a new location and have given them a one year timeline to find a new location. We are disappointed they were not able to move to their new location. With limited options for a new location the Hope Center Board decided to cease operations as of the end of the year. We celebrate the 12 years of the ministry of the Hope Center. At the present time, we are not selling the building. Our goal is to explore and shift to a different ministry/mission for our Ministry Center building. We hope for a mission and ministry that is more manageable and continues to support our outreach into the community. We invite your prayers as we seek God's guidance for this new ministry.
