FINANCIAL NEWS

Happy February everyone. As reported, in January we did end the year with a beginning balance of \$15,000, which was great news. But as in previous years, the winter months bring with it some hefty expenditures with increased cost in utilities and the additional cost of such items as snow removal. For the month of January, Rapid City FUMC was \$10,000 short of meeting all our financial obligations through the donations received. In January, the Dakota's Conference sent RC FUMC a check in the amount of \$21,135 to cover the 2024 Health Insurance and Pension obligations for Pastor Richard, for 2024. Health insurance and pension obligations are normally paid by each church, but the conference has agreed to help RC FUMC with this obligation for this year. Because of the receipt of these funds RC FUMC have yet had to transfer from the emergency funds on deposit. The 2024 budget was very conservative, and we are hopeful that going forward we can meet the expected donation rate that were in this budget. Thank you for all your generous support and we are grateful for the faithfulness of each one of our members and friends in your giving to God through Rapid City First! We celebrate the ways we are able to share the wonderful leadership, ministry and programs of our church in sharing the good news of Jesus Christ.



Give Up Something Bad for Lent


This seven week study will be offered at three different times:
