Read Psalm 32:8

Day 3

Read Proverbs 19:21

Do you have a younger brother or sister? Have you ever tried to boss them around? Did they listen? Probably not! Sometimes, we act the same way with God. We know what He wants us to do, but we do the opposite. We know we should tell the truth, but we lie. We know we should let others go first, but we push ahead instead.

It's important to remember that God has a plan and His plan is always best. God wants everyone to know Him and have a friendship with Him through Jesus. We can ask God to guide us and help us follow His plan for our lives. What's your plan for today? What do you want to do? Tell God your plans, and ask Him to help you make good choices that show love and honor to Him all day long.

Day 4

Go on a prayer walk around your house. Stop in three different places in and pray about situations where you need to trust God. It could be related to the room you're in . . . like, maybe at the kitchen table where you will do your homework, you ask God for help in school this year, and in the family room, you thank God for your family and pray that He will protect you, and outside in your yard, you can pray that God will help you be a good witness in your neighborhood.

As you end each prayer, close with this sentence, "God, I trust You no matter what."
