Activities

The Animals Say

You'll Do:

- Pick up one animal at a time and make the sound the animal makes.
- Continue as long as interest holds.

You'll Talk About:

"Look at the dog. (Hold up the toy dog.) What does the dog say? Woof! Woof! Here's a lion. (Hold up the toy lion.) What does the lion say? Roar! Good job! (Hold up the toy donkey.) This is a donkey, and it says hee-haw, hee-haw! (Hold up the toy owl.) And this is an owl! Owls say hoo-hoo! God made all the animals and God made you! God made everything to the moon and back!"

Look Up at the Stars

You'll Do:

- Close and secure the bottom of the box with packing tape.
- Cut the top flaps off the box and discard.
- Lay the box on its side and randomly punch a few holes through the "top" of the box.
- Cut ribbon in 12-inch lengths.
- Knot one end of each ribbon then thread one through each hole in the top of the box.
- Knot the other end of each ribbon around the stars. Adjust the length of each ribbon to allow children to lay beneath.
- Encourage children to lay on their backs while they observe and play with the stars.

You'll Talk About:

"[Child's name] come lay down and look at all the stars! Wow! They are so pretty! Can you touch a star? God made the stars and God made you! God made everything!"

Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star

You'll Do:

 Sing and do the hand motions to the song "Twinkle, Twinkle Little Star."

You'll Talk About:

"Twinkle, twinkle little star. (Alternate opening and closing your right hand and left hand.)
How I wonder what you are. (Hands to your side with palms up and shrug shoulders.)
Up above the world so high. (Point up.)
Like a diamond in the sky. (Make a diamond shape with your thumbs and pointer fingers together.)

Creation Tangle

You'll Do:

- Place a few Little People®; animals; and the sun, moon, and star toys in the laundry basket.
- Weave the yarn back and forth through the openings at the top of the laundry basket, leaving larger spaces for children to reach through.
- Encourage children to reach into the basket and pull an item out. Talk about the item they pulled out

You'll Talk About:

"[Child's name] help me get the toys out of the basket. Yay! It's a [creation item]! God made the [item], and God made you! Look! You pulled out the [creation item]! God made the [item], and God made you! God made so many amazing and wonderful things! (Hold up several of the toys.) God made everything to the moon and back!"
