Prayer

Weekly Parent Cues



Morning Time

When you go into your child's room, cuddle them and say "Good morning" in different animal voices. Then say: "God made all of the animals. Which animal is your favorite?"



Cuddle Time

Cuddle with your child and pray: "God, You made everything. That's A LOT! But even though You made everything, You still care about [name of child] and me like we are the only thing You ever made. You love us that much!"



Drive Time

While on the go, try and say, "God made you!" every time you see a person. Talk about how God made and loves every person in the whole wide world!



Bath Time

Add small toy animals and a washcloth to bath time. Take turns hiding an animal under the washcloth. When a person hides an animal, they will make its sound. The other person will guess what animal is hiding. Lift the washcloth to see if they got it right. Then say: "God made the [animal]!"
