



HISTORY

In late 2016 Blair Cushman, his family, and several other families were sent to New Braunfels from Kerrville Bible Church to plant Redemption Bible Church. Redemption began meeting for Core Group at the beginning of 2017 with a handful of committed families. On October 1, 2017 we launched and began meeting regularly for Sunday morning service. In January of 2018 small groups were launched in homes across New Braunfels that meet weekly. November 17, 2019 was the first service in our current building.

These efforts have been largely opportunistic and as God has grown our church we desire to be more strategic in how we are developing not only church planting and lead pastors but also worship and soul care pastors to carry our DNA into churches.

In 2024 we launched a strategic initiative called ²Build What Lasts to raise money to expand our facility and fund residents.

Sent members Matt and Marissa Boubel to Northern Ireland to do student discipleship in 2023.

2024

Partnered in training Shamus Drake and Tony Alejo as church planters with Crossway Bible Church through the creation of the Church Leader Multiplier (CLM) in 2024.
