Take Time to be Thankful

Thankful for God's Love

Consider all of the things we are able to measure; weight, length, depth, volume, mass, size, etc. Nearly everything in our world is capable of being measured by either using a device or a formula as an estimate. We can even measure stars, planets, and nebulae out in space! But there's one thing that is so large that we are completely incapable of even beginning to measure: God's love. We can experience God's love and see the effects it has on us, but we can't possibly measure the magnitude of how much God loves us. 1 Chronicles 16:34 says, "Give thanks to the LORD, for He is good; His faithful love endures forever." Are you thankful for God's love? Does that thought cross your mind often? We have so many things for which to be thankful, but God's love deserves our extreme gratitude.

Thankful in all Circumstances

The next one is a bit more difficult, and that is to be thankful in all circumstances. 1 Thessalonians 5:17-18 says, "Pray constantly. Give thanks in everything, for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus." But is it always easy to be thankful when life is difficult? Of course not. Especially when we are suffering the loss of someone we loved, we receive an unexpected diagnosis, or when addictions and vices are tearing us apart. Yet, we can still find thankfulness because in those situations we can remember that God is with us in our pain and He is continuing to work out all things so that His glory will prevail in the end. Let's work on being thankful in the good times, in the bad times, and even in the mundane because God is alive and well.

Thankfulness in Jesus Christ

The foundation for our thankfulness is found in Jesus Christ. If you need help understanding this thought, then play the "perspective game" with me for just a moment. Consider what Jesus gave up when He left heaven to come down to earth as a human. Then consider how He endured every temptation that you have experienced yet did not sin. Now consider how when He was hanging on a cross, that He was dying for your sin. Finally, consider how when Jesus conquered death by being raised to life that He lives for you. When you put all of life within that perspective, we obviously are indebted with thankfulness for Jesus! Colossians 3:16-17 says, "Let the message about the Messiah dwell richly among you, teaching and admonishing one another in all wisdom, and singing psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, with gratitude in your hearts to God. And whatever you do, in word or in deed, do everything in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through Him." May your Thanksgiving season be truly blessed!
