“Shelter From The Storm”



“When I’m In A Storm, God Will Keep Me Safe!”



“God is our refuge and strength, always ready to help in times of trouble.”

– Psalm 46:1

Say:

Storms come in all shapes and sizes. And they are all scary and can cause a lot of damage.

Discuss:

- What kinds of storms have you been in? (thunderstorms, tornadoes, hurricanes, etc.)
- How did you feel during those storms?
- What did you do during the storm to feel safe?

Say:

Life is full of storms, as well. They may not be weather storms, but they are storms that bring trouble and difficulty in our lives. Those kind of storms can be very scary too!

Read:

Genesis 6-7

Discuss:

- How many of each animal did God send to the ark?
- Did Noah have to catch all the animals? How did they get to the ark?
- How many days and night did it rain?
- Did Noah obey God’s instructions?

Say:

It wasn’t easy, but Noah and his family obeyed God in the middle of a horrible storm. When they obeyed, they saw God’s amazing power at work and they were saved from the storm.

When we follow God and obey His instructions (no matter how hard they are), we will see miracles in our own lives. God will keep us safe in the middle of life’s storms.

Pray:

Pray for your children if they are facing a storm. Pray they would find safety in their Comforter and that God would provide a miracle and shelter them from the storm.
