Share the Gospel & Trust God

- 4:1-20 The Parable of the Soils
 - Farmers sow consistently and abundantly.
 - Seeds take root based on the soil condition.
 - Believers are to share the Gospel consistently and abundantly.

Share the Gospel & Trust God

- 4:1-20 The Parable of the Soils
 - We don't control how people respond.
 - Many/most will “fizzle out”
 - Those who Persevere until the end!
 - Matt. 24:9-12; Heb. 6:11-12; Rev. 2:25-26

Share the Gospel & Trust God

- 4:21-25 The Lamp on a Stand
 - It makes no sense to cover up a lit lamp
 - Believers are lights to non-believers.
 - Sharing the TRUTH about God, man, sin, repentance and full life in Him!
 - Matt. 5:14-16

Share the Gospel & Trust God

- 4:26-29 The Parable of the Sower
 - Sowers have one job: plant and water.
 - They do not cause growth, they just submit to the process GOD has ordained!
 - GUARANTEE: You cannot reap a harvest if you never sow.

Share the Gospel & Trust God

- 4:26-29 The Parable of the Sower
 - Share the Gospel and Trust God!
 - It is GOD who causes salvation and growth
 - But we DO have a job... sow seed!
 - Rom. 10:12-14
