

Excerpts from Pastor Emeka Okide's message at the Digging for Gold and July Holy Communion Service on Tuesday, July 8, 2025

Bible Text: Psalm 82:5-7

Rany people lack knowledge of their divine identity as gods. Psalm 82:6 reveals this truth, and Jesus reaffirmed it in John 10:34 (KJV): "Is it not written in your law, I said, Ye are gods?" He emphasized the immutability of Scripture and the authority we have when we abide in Him. John 15:7 (KJV) states, "If ye abide in me, and my words abide in you, ye shall ask what ye will, and it shall be done unto you."

To walk in the supernatural, you must first know who God is. He calls things that are not as though they

were, and they become what He declares. God cannot lie. If you want to operate like God, you must activate your creative power by speaking in faith, as He does.

1 John 5:4 (KJV) declares, "For whatsoever is born of God overcometh the world..." Your victory is in your faith. Romans 8:14 (KJV) says, "For as many as are led by the Spirit of God, they are the sons of God." As sons of God, if the Word abides in us and we abide in Him, we step into our supernatural heritage.

Key ingredients for walking in the supernatural are faith, knowledge,

understanding, revelation, and being led by the Spirit. Many Christians live beneath their potential because they lack the knowledge of their new identity in Christ. This divine life—Zoe—is accessed by knowing God's Word and acting on it in faith.

Man is a spirit, has a soul, and lives in a body (1 Thessalonians 5:23). God created us in His image. Jesus came to restore the spirit man, reconnecting us to our lost dominion after the fall of Adam. His death on the Cross satisfied the requirement for sin and reopened the gate to fellowship with God (Psalm 24:9).

If you are born again, your spirit has come alive, and you have access to a life of dominion. Mark 16:17 (KJV) says, "And these signs shall follow them that believe..." This is your inheritance. You are now seated in heavenly places, far above principalities. When you are born of God, you are born to win and live as a sign and a wonder. These signs are activated by faith in God's Word.

The Word of God proved true in the lives of Apostle Paul, Elijah, and Joshua. Today, you have a better

covenant based on better promises (Hebrews 8:6). Job 22:28 (KJV) says, "Thou shalt also decree a thing, and it shall be established..." God is waiting for your decrees.

Why are some believers not walking in the supernatural?

- **1. Lack of knowledge** (Hosea 4:6). You must see yourself through the mirror of God's Word.
- **2. Lack of faith.** Unbelief hinders participation in God's blessings.
- **3. Sin.** It blocks your prayers and weakens your decrees.
- **4. Lack of bravery.** Don't let past failures paralyze your faith. Be bold and move forward in God.

As you rediscover who you are in Christ, walk in the Spirit and holiness (John 3:6). You must have a relationship with Jesus Christ. If you're still living in sin, surrender to Him now, so you can begin to operate in the supernatural.

ANONYMOUS - GOD'S GOODNESS


Our God is truly merciful and faithful. I thank Him on behalf of my sweetheart and me for visiting our family specially this year.


ANONYMOUS - SUCCESS

I glorify God for seeing me through medical school. I thank Him for provision, strength, and in advance, for a successful induction into the medical profession next month.


