The bank teller looked at her and said," I do see that money was deposited into your account yesterday. But our policy is if you do not use the amount deposited that day, you lose the remaining funds at the end of the day."

"I'm sorry, WHAT?!" the lady responded. "How is that okay?"

The bank teller frowned, "I'm sorry, ma'am. Unfortunately, there is. nothing I can do to help. The remaining funds from your deposit are no longer available."

The teller then apologized and closed her account.

We should take advantage of every single one of those minutes of each and every day to give glory and honor to God. We don't want to look back and see all those wasted minutes, hours, or days. One thing I have been reminded of this past week is that every moment of every day is precious. The moments we spend with each other are not just some happenstance of the universe. They are gifts. 




