We want to celebrate how God moved in 2025

We have grown in our worship


- We set a new expectation for worship through singing and prayer through 3 different worship nights
- Sundays have continued to grow in attendance, including the number of kids in our kids' ministry.
- We have seen 16 people say yes to believing in Jesus on Sundays, and 16 people follow
 Jesus in Baptism
- We led our first VBS which saw more than 50 volunteers and 50 kids participate
- We have trained over 50 people to learn how to share their story as a way to share the
 gospel.
- Future Building Fund has grown to \$891,000

We have grown in our community

- We see 82% of our church membership involved in groups. And 46% of our regular attenders in groups.
- We developed a training course and are instilling a rhythm to help build and equip new group leaders for future multiplication.
- Our family ministries are impacting over 80 kids, youth, and young adults every week

We have pursued the Mission

- We fed over 600 people and spent multiple weeks in hurricane recovery.
- Our Thanksgiving meal drive helped to serve over 100 families.
- Our Serve day in February allowed us to deploy 85 people to tangibly show the love of Jesus to our community.
- We have formed partnership to support 6 different local schools



We will provide more opportunities for more people to participate in community with others who are with Jesus, becoming like Jesus, and doing as Jesus did.

As followers of Jesus Christ we are called to make disciples that make disciples. A disciple loves all people, discovers their identity in Jesus and seeks to deepen their relationship with Jesus and the faith family.


What's your next step of obedience?

Practicing Regular and Consistent Rhythms of Worship, Community, and Mission

We believe mature disciples consistently participate in the rhythms of worship, community, and mission. Without this maturity, it is difficult to entrust leadership and multiplication to others.

- **Community:** Everyone belongs in a group led by equipped leaders. Each group follows the church seasons and intentionally multiplies, helping disciples grow and prepare to lead others.
- Mission: Mature disciples faithfully serve their community, sharing God's love and hope in tangible ways. We will channel local missions and serve days through groups, allowing them to become more meaningful and impactful.
- Worship: Mature disciples engage fully in both personal and corporate worship, regularly encountering God's presence. They participate in worship through the giving of their time, gifts, energy, & finances.

By embracing these rhythms, we grow deeper together, building a resilient, vibrant discipleship culture where God's blessing flows freely through worship, community, and mission.

Our goal by the end of 2030 is to...


- Plant 1 new church to help reach the south shore
