The Code

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Animal Action Cards and Color Sorting Game.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Bark Color Pages (1 per kid) crayons, Bark Color Pgs, crayons, "Star Template" printable (3 per group); Red, yellow, and blue paper (several); Painter's tape (1 per group); Scissors (1 per group; adult-use only) Beanbags (several), Construction paper (5 per group), Marker (1 per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Amazing job, Super Crew! Thank you so much for your help. In our Bible story today, God helped Joseph get ready for what would happen next. Joseph did not know what would happen, but he trusted God would be with him and help him. Joseph trusted God's plan for him. God had a plan for Joseph to help save God's people, and he did! Today's Bible story helps us know that God has a plan for us. We can look up and remember that God sees the great big plan for our lives. Our Super Clue is a telescope. A telescope can help us look up and see things that are hard to see, but God sees everything! We can look up and trust that He always has a plan for us.

Let's pray, which is talking and listening to God. We can thank Him for His plan for us.

God, thank You for Your love. Help us trust You and Your plan for our lives each day. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Yippee! (Bring closed fists to shoulders. Push them up into the sky and open hands.) **God Has a Plan for Me!** (Cross arms in front of body, making a small circle with palms up.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Make Your Own Telescope(20 minutes)

Preschoolers will make their own telescopes.

Big Goal: Understand that God has a plan, even when we can't see it.

Supplies: Cardstock (1 per child), Stickers (several), Markers or crayons (several), Tape (1 per group)

Craft Instructions:

- 1. Give each child a sheet of cardstock and markers or crayons.
- 2. Encourage preschoolers to decorate their papers however they would like.
- 3. Assist preschoolers in rolling up their papers into tubes. Tape the ends of the paper.
- 4. Provide stickers for preschoolers to use to decorate the telescope when it is finished.

What To Do: Does anyone remember what our Super Clue is today? (Allow responses.) Yes! Our Super Clue is a telescope. Let's make our own pretend telescopes. I will give each of you a sheet of paper and crayons. Decorate your paper however you would like. When you are ready, a leader will come by and help you roll up and tape your telescope. You can add stickers to your telescope once it is rolled up if you would like.

Loud And Clear: A telescope helps us look up and see things that are far away and hard to see. We can look up and trust God one step at a time. When you use a telescope at night, you can see all the beautiful stars God created. God created you and me, and He loves us. Don't forget that God has a plan for each of us.

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (a telescope)
- What does a telescope help us remember? (We can look up and trust that God has a plan for us.)
- I can look up. How does looking up help us remember that God has a plan for us? (We can look up. We don't just look up with our heads and eyes to the sky. When we look up it means that we can know or remember that God has a plan for us, even when it is hard to see all the details of that plan. We can look up and trust God one step at a time.)
- What did you learn about God today?
- Who can you tell that God has a plan for them?

Our Big Deal is, Yippee! God has a plan for Me!

Yippee! (Bring closed fists to shoulders. Push them up into the sky and open hands.)

God Has a Plan for Me! (Cross arms in front of body, making a small circle with palms up.)

God has a plan for you. We can trust God as we look up to Him.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
 As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
