

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, "Give A Gift" printable (1 per group), Painter's tape (1 per group), Stickers (4 per child), "Manger Movements" printable (1 set per group), Foam Window Dice (1 per group), Cardboard box (optional), Tape (1 per group; optional) (1 per group;

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! Today we have learned that God gives us love. In our Bible story, we learned that God sent His Son, Jesus, as a baby. After Jesus was born, an angel appeared to the shepherds and told them the good news of Jesus' birth. God showed how much He loves us by sending Jesus to be with us. Because of Jesus, we can have a friendship with God. That is some super big love! Our Super Clue today is a manger scene. A manger scene helps us remember that God sent Jesus to be with us. God loves us and is always with us.

Let's pray, which is talking and listening to God, and thank God for Jesus.

God, thank You for loving us by sending Jesus to be with us. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Best Gift Ever! (Take a present and pretend to push it forward.)

God Is Always with Me! (Reach up with both hands open, pointing inward. Bring them down to your chest.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Make a Manger Scene— (20 minutes)

Preschoolers will make a manger scene.

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story.

Leader Prep: Print "Make A Manger Scene" printables on cardstock.

Supplies: "Make A Manger Scene" printables (1 per child), Cardstock (1 per child), Manger Scene Sticker set (1 per kid) Tape (several), Markers or crayons (several), "Session 3 Bible Story" printable (1 per group; optional)

Craft Instructions:

- 1. Before the session, print "Make A Manger Scene" printables on cardstock, one per child.
- 2. Give each preschooler markers or crayons to color the manger scene and picture squares.
- 3. Invite preschoolers to retell the Bible story.

What To Do: Let's make a fun craft called "Make a Manger Scene." What is it called? (Make a Manger Scene!) Good job! Each friend is going to get a manger scene picture, and a sheet of stickers. We will turn place the stickers on our papers so we can practice telling our Bible story about Jesus being born. We will color our manger scene. When we finish our manger scenes, we are going to practice retelling our Bible story. Ready? Let's get started.

Leader Tip: Help preschoolers retell the Bible story. There is a copy of the Bible story you can print off and use it to help preschoolers if needed.

Loud And Clear: Your manger scenes look amazing! In our Bible story today, the shepherds heard the good news about Jesus being born, and they went to Bethlehem to worship Jesus. Then they went and told others the good news that Jesus was born. We can share that good news with others too. Think of someone you can show your picture to share today's Bible story with and tell them the next time you see them.

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (a manger scene)
- What does a manger scene help us remember? (We see a manger scene at Christmastime to remember and celebrate that Jesus was born. Jesus is the best gift ever because God sent Jesus to be with us.)
- What was something you liked from the Bible story today?
- God gives me love. God showed us how much He loves us by sending Jesus to be with us. Who can you tell about how God gives us love?
- What did you learn about God today?

Keep It Going: Choose a preschooler to lead the Big Deal call and repeat. Invite preschoolers to repeat the Big Deal after the leader. Assist as needed with remembering the words and motions.

Big Deal Motions:

Best Gift Ever! (Take a present and pretend to push it forward.) God Is Always with Me! (Reach up with both hands open, pointing inward. Bring them down to your chest.)

We can know that God is always with us as we experience God's love. God gives us love through Jesus. Jesus was born just like God promised.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
 As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
