The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Animal Action Dice and Heart Seek and Find.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, "Let's be Kind" (one set per group)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Amazing! Thank you, Super Crew and Bark! Today we learned that God's love is kind. God sent Peter to Cornelius' house to tell him a special message that everyone who believes in Jesus can be forgiven. Forgiveness means that God "lets go of our sin." Sins are the wrong choices we make. God forgives us when we ask Him because He is kind, and He loves us. God's love is not just for some people and not others. God's love is kind, and it is for everyone. When we believe in Jesus, we can ask God to forgive our sins and wrong choices.

Our Super Clue today is a valentine heart. On Valentine's Day, we give valentine hearts to show kindness and love for everyone. It is so kind to give valentine hearts to our friends. It lets them know that we care about them. God loves them too.

Let's talk and listen to God. This is called prayer. Ready? Let's pray in 3-2-1.

God, thank You for loving us so much. Thank You that Your love is for everyone. Help us never forget how much You love us, and help us tell our friends and family all about Your love for them. In Jesus' name, amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

L-O-V-E! (Cross arms over chest and rotate your body for every letter.)

God Loves Me! (Point up with open palms to the sky. Bring hands to chest.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Heart Stamps- Craft (20 minutes)

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story and the Main Idea: God's love is kind.

Leader Prep: Print "Heart Stamps" printables on cardstock, one per child. Cut cardboard tubes in half and bend the circle to form a heart shape. Secure with rubber bands. Make a sample craft.

Supplies: "Heart Stamps" printable (1 per child), Cardstock (1 per child), Rubber bands (several), Washable paint (several), Paper plates (several), Cardboard tubes (several), Adult scissors (1 per group), Painting smocks or large T-shirts (1 per child), Washable ink pads (several; optional), "Heart Stamps Instructions & Example" printable (1 per group; optional)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print "Heart Stamps" printables on cardstock, one per child. Cut cardboard tubes in half and bend the circle to form a heart shape. Secure with rubber bands. Make a sample craft.
2. Give each preschooler a "Heart Stamps" printable. Assist preschoolers in putting on painting smocks.
3. Squirt paint on a paper plate.
4. Give each preschooler a cardboard tube "stamper" with the tip shaped like a heart.
5. Dip the end of the cardboard tube in paint (or press on an ink pad) and stamp it on the "Heart Stamps" sheet.
6. Continue decorating as time and interest allow.

What To Do: A valentine is a special card that you give to someone. We are special to God. We are also special to our friends and family. We are going to make a valentine that says God's love is kind. I am going to give everyone half of a cardboard tube. You will gently dip the end of the tube in the paint and then stamp the heart on your paper. Keep adding hearts to your paper until you have all that you would like.

Leader Tip: Remind preschoolers to be gentle with the cardboard tube when dipping it in the paint and stamping the paper. Place sheets in a safe place to dry.

Loud And Clear: You did a great job decorating your paper with heart stamps. I am so proud of your good work! During our Large Group time we learned that God's love is kind. God sent Peter to tell Cornelius that His love is for everyone. God's love is not just for a few people but for everyone. God's love is for you, and God's love is for me. Let's say the words on the papers we just stamped together. I will say them first, and you can say them after me. God's love is kind. (God's love is kind.) One more time! God's love is kind. (God's love is kind.) Way to go!

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*a valentine heart*)
- What does a valentine heart help us remember? (*On Valentine's Day, we give valentine hearts to show kindness and love for everyone. In today's Bible story, we learned that **God's love is kind**, and it is for everyone.*)
- What special message did God send Peter to tell Cornelius? (*Everyone who believes in Jesus can be forgiven and have a friendship with God.*)
- **God's love is kind.** How can you show kindness to someone? (*talk to them, play with them, share toys with them, and so on*)
- What did you learn about God today?
- Do you remember today's Big Deal? Repeat after me (*with motions below*): L-O-V-E! (*L-O-V-E!*) God Loves Me! (*God Loves Me!*)

Keep It Going: Form two groups of preschoolers. Assign one group "L-O-V-E!" and the other group "God Loves Me!" When you point to each group, encourage them to say their parts of the Big Deal.

Big Deal Motions:

L-O-V-E! (*Cross arms over chest and rotate your body for every letter.*)

God Loves Me! (*Point up with open palms to the sky. Bring hands to chest.*)

God sent Peter to Cornelius' house to tell him God's love is for everyone. Since **God's love is kind**, His love is for everyone. Anyone one who believes in Jesus can be forgiven because **God's love is kind**. God loves you, and God loves me. We are special to God!

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
