Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew! In our Bible story today, God showed His amazing power through Peter and healed a woman named Dorcas (DAWR kuhs). God can do all things and takes care of us because He is powerful.

Our Super Clue is the solar system. The solar system is big and shows us how powerful God is. Something that is so big and deep could only be made by a very big and powerful God. He controls everything by His power. That means He keeps the planets turning in the solar system, He controls the weather, and He takes care of you and me! He is there to help us and care for us. God is always powerful!

Let's say a prayer to God. This means we are going to talk and listen to God. Let's get still so we can pray.

God, thank You for all of my friends here today. We have had so much fun learning about how You are powerful. Thank You for taking care of us and loving us. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Every Day and Every Way! (Present your right hand with palm up, then your left hand with palm up.)

God Takes Care of Me! (Hug arms across your chest.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Night And Day — Craft**

Preschoolers will draw things they do during the day and at night.

Leader Prep: Cut two pieces of butcher paper. Draw a sun on one and a moon on the other. Cut out the Day and Night pictures so there is one picture per square.

Supplies: Butcher paper (2 per group), Markers or crayons (several), Adult scissors (1 per group) Night and Day Pictures (cut into individual pictures), glue sticks

What To Do: I am so glad you are here today! We are going to make a craft called "Night and Day." What is it called? (*Night and Day!*) Great! On one piece of paper, we have a sun. On the other piece of paper, we have a moon. The sun reminds us of the day. Let's say, "Day," together. "Day." Good! The moon reminds us of night. Let's say, "Night," together. "Night." Great! On the paper with the sun, I want you to draw and paste things you do in the daytime. On the paper with the moon, I want you to draw and paste things you do at nighttime. Are you ready to draw? (Allow responses.) Let's start!

Connect It: Today's Theme is *Every Day and Every Way*. Thinking about night and day reminds me of the part of our Theme that says *Every Day*. One thing we will talk about today is that God takes care of us. It does not matter if it is day or night—He takes care of us all day, every day! That is great news we can celebrate together.

When you look at our papers, how does night and day show you that God is so powerful? Can you draw some pictures that show what powerful looks like?

How does the Bible story about Dorcas help us remember God is so powerful? Can you draw some pictures from the Bible story today to help us remember how the Bible teaches us that God is powerful?

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (*the solar system*)
- What does the solar system help us remember? (*The solar system is big and shows us how powerful God is. Something that is so big and deep could only be made by a very big and powerful God.*)
- **God is always powerful.** What are ways that God shows His power every day? (*God shows His power by taking care of us every day and in every way.*)
- What did Peter do once the people left Dorcas' room? (*He knelt down, prayed, and asked God to heal Dorcas. God healed her.*)
- What did you learn about God today?

Keep It Going: Say the Big Deal and spin in place one time after repeating each phrase. The spinning will mimic a planet orbiting in the solar system.

Big Deal Motions:

Every Day and Every Way! (Present your right hand with palm up, then your left hand with palm up.)

God Takes Care of Me! (Hug arms across your chest.)

Friends, I want you to remember that **God is always powerful.** God takes care of us because He is powerful and in control of all things. Because God is powerful, we can trust Him to take care of us.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
