SOCIAL TIME

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, "Allergy Alert" printable (1 per group), Yellow balloons (several)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thanks, Super Crew, for helping us understand how our Super Clue connects to our Big Deal. In our Bible story today, a man named Paul told the people who followed Jesus to put on the armor of God and to pray for God's people. God was with His people, and they could always talk and listen to Him anytime and anywhere through prayer. God is always with us, too, and we can talk and listen to God anytime through prayer.

Our Super Clue is a winter coat. When it's cold, we wear our winter coats everywhere we go. God is always with us. He cares about us and protects us wherever we go. I am so glad to know this winter coat can remind us of how God is always with us.

Let's pray and talk and listen to God now. God always hears to our prayers.

God, thank You for always being with us. Thank You for taking care of us and protecting us.

Thank You that we can talk to You anytime and that You always hear our prayers. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Every Day and Every Way! *(Present your right hand with palm up, then your left hand with palm up.)*

God Takes Care of Me! *(Hug arms across your chest.)*

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)**Decorate A Shield —**

Preschoolers will decorate a shield.

Big Goal: Remember the Bible story.

Leader Prep: Print "Decorate A Shield" printables on cardstock, one per child. Cut out the shield and strip.

Supplies: "Decorate A Shield" printable (1 per child), Cardstock (1 per child), Crayons (several), Tape (1 per group), Adult scissors (1 per group)

Craft Instructions:

1. Before the session, print "Decorate A Shield" printables on cardstock, one per child. Cut out the shield and strip.
2. Give preschoolers crayons and a shield.
3. Invite preschoolers to decorate their shields with crayons.
4. Help preschoolers tape the handle on the back of the shield.

What To Do: Today we learned about the armor of God. We are going to make a craft called "Decorate a Shield." Decorate a what? (A shield!) Great! Each of you will get a shield to decorate with crayons. When you finish, I will help you tape the handle on the back so you can hold your shield up and use it. Are you ready to get started? Let's decorate!

Loud And Clear: Your shields look so good! In our Bible story today, Paul told the people in his letter that God has given us His armor to wear and protect us while we follow Him. A shield is a part of that armor. God gives us the gift of prayer so we can talk to Him anytime. We have so many things we can pray about and thank God for today. God is always with us and takes care of us.

TALK IT OUT

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? *(a winter coat)*
- What does a winter coat help us remember? *(We carry a winter coat with us everywhere when it is cold outside. God is always with us too. No matter where we go, God is with us.)*
- Who did Paul tell the people they can always talk to? *(Paul told the people to pray, talk, and listen to God, who is always with them and can protect them.)*
- **God is always with me.** Who can you tell that God is always with you?
- What did you learn about God today?

Keep It Going: Invite preschoolers to volunteer to say the Big Deal on their own if they would like. Be quick to step in and help preschoolers who may not remember every part.

Big Deal Motions:

Every Day and Every Way! (Present your right hand with palm up, then your left hand with palm up.)

God Takes Care of Me! (Hug arms across your chest.)

God's armor helps us follow Him. God takes care of us and gives us all that we need.

GOING HOME

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
- As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this week.
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
