**BIBLE-** God Spoke with Job- Job 1-42

**Read:** Job 1-42

Highlight: Job 42:1-2

**Reflect:** Job did not understand why bad things were happening to him, yet he trusted in God. How can you practically trust in God when you are hurting?

- 1. Surrender control of the situation, and trust God's timing and plan.
- 2. Worship through pain by singing, praying, and reading your Bible.
- 3. Allow friends and family to join you in prayer, and offer support as a community.

**Pray:** God, help me to focus on Your goodness in the middle of my pain. I know You can do all things, and Your plans cannot be altered. So I trust in Your power that my hurt will be used for Your glory.

**Connect:** We often cannot see anything good while we are in the middle of something hard. In hindsight, what have you learned from a tough season in your life?

Tips to Help Kids Feel Welcomed:

- Be Inquisitive-get to know their name and ask engaging questions
- Be Intentional- transitions, expectations and locations help kids know what to expect and when
- Be relational- it starts with you, help kids make connections based on conversations
- Be encouraging- kind and encouraging words go a long way
