Read: Nehemiah 1-3

Highlight: Nehemiah 2:19-20

Reflect: Nehemiah was confident that God was going to make him successful in rebuilding the wall. How can I also trust that God is aware and working in my life?

- 1. Remember God's faithfulness in the big things and small things.
- 2.Be confident in God's provisions.
- 3. Trust in God's bigger plan for your life.

Pray: God, this week I choose to place my confidence in knowing that You know every situation I face. I know that I can trust You even when I can't see the outcome. Help me to rest in Your faithfulness and goodness.

Connect: Nehemiah had the confidence in God to continue rebuilding the wall, despite people saying it was not possible. How has God revealed His perfect plan to you in a situation that seemed impossible?

Tips to Help Kids Feel Welcomed:

- Be Inquisitive-get to know their name and ask engaging questions
- Be Intentional- transitions, expectations and locations help kids know what to expect and when
- Be relational- it starts with you, help kids make connections based on conversations
- Be encouraging- kind and encouraging words go a long way
