The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

- This month you have Magnet Blocks with Shape/Number Cards and Animal Action Dice.
- You will also find 2 Social activities each week. **Use one now and one at the end to redirect attention.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games, Play dough (1 per child), Play coins or toy animals (several), "Allergy Alert" printable (1 per group) Pom-poms (several), Solid color cups (several)

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Thank you, Super Crew! Today we learned that God values us. In our Bible story, Jesus told two stories about valuable, special things that were lost. When they were found, the people celebrated with excitement. God cares about us, and we are so important to Him! Our Super Clue, a piggy bank, holds important and valuable things like money. God says that we are very valuable and important to Him. God values us so much that He sent His Son, Jesus, so that we can be forgiven and have a friendship with Him. When we choose to follow Jesus, that is a big deal, and it is something really special to celebrate! Let's pray and thank God for valuing us. Prayer is talking and listening to God. Close your eyes so you aren't distracted by anyone else and let's talk to God in 3-2-1.

God, thank You for true stories in the Bible that help us see that You value us. When we turn to You and ask for Your forgiveness, we can have a friendship with You. Thank You for sending Jesus to make that possible. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Jump In! (Make a small hop forward.)

God Gives Me Friends! (Bring hands together in front of you.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Treasure Box- Craft (20 minutes)

Preschoolers will decorate a treasure box to remember God Values Me!

Big Goal: Remember the Main Idea, "God Values Us!"

Supplies: <u>Treasure Box</u> (1 per kid), stickers, plastic coins (4-per kid), God Values Me Sticker (1 per kid)

What To Do: Welcome! I am so excited to spend time with you today. Let's work together to make a special box—a treasure box! A what? (A treasure box!) Great! When we treasure something, we care about it, so we might put it in a safe place. Let's work together as a team to turn this empty box into a treasure box. We can use markers, crayons, and stickers to decorate our box. I can't wait to see how amazing this box will be once you finish working together to decorate it. (As preschoolers work, encourage them to talk about what they would put inside a treasure box.)

Leader Tip: If your group is larger, provide several boxes to decorate. Form small groups of preschoolers to decorate each box. Give each kid 4 plastic coins to put in their treasure box.

Connect It: God values us. When we find something valuable, we are excited, and we celebrate. Let's say, "**God values us!**" Ready? (*God values us!*) Great job! God values us so much that He sent His Son, Jesus, so that we can be forgiven and have a friendship with Him. That is something big worth celebrating!

Say:

- Who remembers what our Super Clue is today? (a piggy bank)
- What does a piggy bank help us remember? (A piggy bank holds important and valuable things like money. God says we are very valuable and important to Him.)
- Who did God send so we could be forgiven and have a friendship with Him? (Jesus)
- God values us. How did God show that He values us? (God sent His Son, Jesus.)
- What did you learn about God today?
- Do you remember today's Big Deal? I'll say it first, and you say it after me (with motions below): Jump In! (Jump In!) God Gives Me Friends! (God Gives Me Friends!)

Keep It Going: Face a friend and say the Big Deal with motions. Then find a different friend and say the Big Deal together. Continue as time allows, encouraging preschoolers to say the Big Deal with different friends in the room.

Big Deal Motions:

Jump In! (Make a small hop forward.) God Gives Me Friends! (Bring hands together in front of you.)

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
 As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
