The Lord's Prayer- We can trust God for food, forgiveness, and help. Matthew 6:9-13

Bible- Nov 5- *Matthew 6:11 & Psalm 121-* Asking for help is part of prayer.

Read: Matthew 6:11; Psalm 121

In This Passage: Jesus teaches us to ask God for what we need. Psalm 121 is an example of this kind of prayer; travelers asked for God's help as they faced a dangerous journey. The psalmist writes, "My help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth!"

You'll Be Teaching: Asking for help is part of prayer. Kids are used to asking for help from adults; there are a lot of things they can't do on their own. But turning to God for help may not be their first instinct. Help them recognize that whenever we face difficulties, big or small, we can ask God for help.

Think About: What's something you've been trying to tackle on your own? Ask God for help right now.

Dig In to Prayer: Ask God to teach your kids to rely on his strength rather than their own.

Quick Tip: Working with kids presents its own challenges. William won't stop goofing off. Lauren keeps chatting with her friends during worship. Cody complains about everything. When you face a tough discipline situation, take three seconds to pause and say a quick prayer, like "God, help me with this." Rely on him to help you manage your classroom well; don't try to do it on your own.
