The Lord's Prayer- We can trust God for food, forgiveness, and help. Matthew 6:9-13

Bible-Oct 22- Matthew 6:9 & Psalm 100 Praise is part of prayer.

Read: Matthew 6:9; Psalm 100

In This Passage: Jesus teaches to start a prayer with praise. Psalm 100 is a great example of a prayer of praise, exclaiming that we can shout with joy to the Lord, sing with joy, enter his gates with thanksgiving and praise, and proclaim his unfailing love and goodness.

You'll Be Teaching: Praise is part of prayer. This is a noisy lesson because praise is noisy! Psalm 100 tells us to "shout with joy to the Lord, all the earth!" This lesson is a great way to capitalize on kids' energy and desire to be loud. Channel their excitement into praise!

Think About: What are 10 things you'd like to say to praise God?

Dig In to Prayer: Ask God to draw your kids into his awesome presence, where they can't help but praise him.

Quick Tip: When you have a lesson like this one where there will be several louder moments, it's great to have an attention-getter that kids know means to settle back down. You could use a loud whistle or other noisemaker or simply a clapping rhythm kids must repeat after you. Using the same attention-getter week after week will help kids know your expectations and will help you better manage the class.
