The Lord's Prayer- We can trust God for food, forgiveness, and help. Matthew 6:9-13

Bible- Oct 29- Matthew 6:10 & 26:36-46- Wanting God's will is part of prayer.

Read: Matthew 6:10; Matthew 26:36-46

In This Passage: Jesus models how to pray by saying "may your will be done on earth, as it is in heaven." Later, as Jesus faces death, he prays a similar prayer, asking for God's will to be done even though it's not what he wants.

You'll Be Teaching: Wanting God's will is part of prayer. One of the most upsetting things for kids is not getting their way. So the idea of praying for God's way, not their own, may be a bit counterintuitive. Help kids see that God's way is best, so that's why it's more desirable than our ways!

Think About: What's an area of your life where you've been focused on your will? Ask God for his will to be done.

Dig In to Prayer: Ask God to give your kids hearts that desire his will above all else.

Quick Tip: Seek God's will in your lesson by holding loosely to your agenda. You may have planned out all you want to accomplish today, but you might have a child who derails your lesson with genuine faith questions or deep, heartfelt pain. Don't be so focused on your plan that you miss these opportunities to minister to kids right where they are.
