Leader Devos

The first 10-15 minutes as kid's arrive are some of our most important times to meet needs and show kids they are valued. This is why we provide strategic activities for you help engage with every kid as they arrive.

Games and Music (10 minutes)

What You Need: Social Game Instruction Page including Roku Games

What You Do:

- Play worship songs and other songs available on Roku during the Social Game or while kids are playing.
- Using the supplies and game instruction page, choose one game to play with the kids today.
- As you are playing, use this as a time to call each kid by name and learn their names well.

Say: That was a fun game to get us ready to watch our Bible video. Let's sit and listen to our story today."

Bible Story - Say This!

Amazing! Thanks so much, Super Crew! In our Bible story, Samuel thought he knew who the right king would be by looking at Jesse's sons on the outside, like how tall or strong he thought they were. But God told Samuel that He knew what was in someone's heart—what we think and feel on the inside. God knew what was in David's heart, and He knew that David was the right person to be the next king. Amazing! God knew every detail about David, and He knows every detail about us too! Every small detail about you is important to God.

Our Super Clue, a feather, is made up of strands. When you look at it one way, it looks like one solid thing, but when you look at it up, down, and all around, you can see that it is made of lots of individual, tiny strands or pieces. You can see all of the details. We all have details about us too—details about what we look like on the outside and details about our thoughts and feelings on the inside. God knows every detail about us, and He loves us!

Let's pray and thank God for knowing every detail about us. Praying is talking and listening to God. Ready? Let's pray.

God, thank You so much for knowing every detail about us. Thank You for knowing our hearts and our feelings. Thank You for loving us very much. Amen.

Can you say the Big Deal with me?

Up, **Down**, **All Around!** (*Place closed fists at head level. Bring them down to your chest. Roll hands over each other in a circular motion.*)

God Knows Me! (Tap each side of your temple with your pointer fingers three times.)

Bible Story Video (10 minutes)

Feather Collage(20 minutes)

Preschoolers will make a feather collage.

Big Goal: Remember the Super Clue and how it teaches us something important about God.

Leader Prep: Print "Feather Collage" printable, one per child, on cardstock. If using double sided tape, place one side on the paper in 2 strips. Leave the paper on the tape to be removed by leaders when the craft is done.

Supplies: "Feather Collage" printable (1 per child), Cardstock (1 per child), Feathers (several), Glue sticks (1 per child) OR Double Sided Tape

Craft Instructions:

- 1. Before the session, print "Feather Collage" printables on cardstock, one per child. Place feathers on the table.
- 2. Give each child a "Feather Collage" crown outline and a glue stick.
- 3. Allow preschoolers to choose feathers to glue inside the crown outline on their papers.

What To Do: Today's Super Clue is a feather. What is it? (A feather!) Yes! Let's make a fun craft using our Super Clue to help us learn something important about God. We are making a feather collage in the shape of a crown. A feather what? (Collage!) Great job! A collage is a special kind of art where we glue different things on our papers. Each of you will get a piece of paper with the outline of a crown on it. There are also feathers on the table for you to use. (Hold a feather up for preschoolers to see.) You will take your glue, put a little bit on your paper inside the crown, and press the feather into the glue wherever you would like. As you make your collage, add as many feathers as you would like.

Leader Tip: Encourage preschoolers to apply glue to their papers and then press the feathers onto the glue. Assist them in applying the glue if needed.

Loud And Clear: Your feather pictures are so beautiful, and I can see all the different details in the different feathers. Our Super Clue today is a feather. Feathers look like one solid shape from a distance. (Hold up a feather for preschoolers to see.) You might notice details or special things about the different feathers we are using, like size, shape, and color. (Pass a feather around for preschoolers to examine, pointing out the different strands and details. Invite them to look at it up, down, and all around.) When you see a feather up close, you can tell that it is made up of many different strands or pieces, and it is incredibly detailed. Isn't that amazing? The next time you see a feather, remember that God knows everything about you. He knows you, and He loves you.

Say:

- What is our Super Clue today? (a feather)
- What does a feather help us remember? (Just like a feather has a lot of small details, we do too—and God knows them all!)
- Today we learned that **God knows every detail** about us. He knows things like what we look like and where we live. God also knows what is going on inside of us, like our thoughts and feelings. What are some thoughts and feelings God knows about us? (God knows when we are happy or when we are sad or scared. God knows when we think right thoughts and wrong thoughts. He knows everything about us, and He loves us.)
- What did you learn about God today?
- God knows every detail about us. Who can you tell about how God knows all about us?

Do you remember today's Big Deal? I will say it first, then you say it after me. (Use the motions below as you say the Big Deal.) Ready? Up, Down, All Around! (Up, Down, All Around!) God Knows Me! (God Knows Me!)

Keep It Going: Say the Big Deal using different speeds. Say it fast, then in slow motion.

Big Deal Motions:

Up, Down, All Around! (Place closed fists at head level. Bring them down to your chest. Roll hands over each other in a circular motion.)

God Knows Me! (Tap each side of your temple with your pointer fingers three times.)

In our Bible story today, God chose David to be king. When Samuel went to meet the new king God had chosen, he was looking at the outside, but God looks at the inside. God sees every detail of our hearts, the things we think and feel. He knows every detail about us, and He loves us.

Prepare kids to talk with their family about what they learned today.

- Pass out coloring pages for kids to take home.
 As family members arrive to pick up their kid, greet them and tell them one thing you noticed about their kid that day or something you talked to each kid about remembering this week.
- If there is time to chat with the family, ask how you can pray for them this
- Say bye to the kids and call them by name.
