What does it mean in 2 Peter 1:5 "make every effort to add to your faith..."?

Read 2 Peter 1:3-4 and Philippians 2:12-13. What part does God have in our personal spiritual growth?

Discuss the logical progression in 2 Peter 1:5-7 for personal spiritual growth. The eight steps listed are: faith, goodness, knowledge, self-control, perseverance, godliness, mutual affection (brotherly love), love (agape). Where are you in this process of growth? Why are loving God and loving people linked?

What is the goal of our spiritual growth according to Ephesians 4:15-16?

What can we do to grow to love God and people?

God uses many things to help disciples grow such as life, hardships, people, church, a retreat or camp. What are some things that God has used in your life to grow you to be more like Jesus?
