These questions are designed to extend the impact of the Sunday gathering. Use them to go deeper in your personal study time, with your family, and/or with your Life Group

1. Which part of the message was most impactful for you and why? Which part of this passage is easiest for you? The hardest?
2. What are the strengths of the Church in Pergamum? What are the weaknesses? What are the commands? What are the rewards?
3. Why do you think Jesus' admonitions were so strong about internal compromise? Why is compromise often more dangerous to the church than open hostility?
4. Where do you feel the strongest pressure to blend faith with cultural expectations? Are there areas where you affirm Christ publicly but struggle to obey Him privately?
5. How do we influence the world with Kingdom values without embracing the world's values?
6. We said, "Revival is standing firm against compromise, which slowly reshapes our loves." Is there an area that of compromise to the world that is slowly reshaping your loves? How might you repent of this?
