American Red Cross Blood Drive

This June, the American Red Cross asks donors to make plans now to give blood or platelets after a concerning shortfall in donations last month. The Red Cross collected over 26,000 fewer blood donations than needed in May to meet the needs of patients.

The start of summer can shake up normal routines, but donation appointments can't fall off the calendar. It's crucial for donors to make and keep their scheduled times to give throughout the summer season.



To help collect blood for patients in need this summer, Christ Lutheran Church - Valparaiso is hosting a blood drive on 6/19/2023. Here is how you can register:

- Download the Blood Donor App and schedule on the app
- Call 1-800-RED CROSS (1-800-733-2767) and let them know you would like to register for this specific drive or visit redcrossblood.org, and search sponsor code: ChristLutheranValpo

- If you are unable to attend worship, you can mail your offerings to the church, or you can place them in the lockbox outside the office door (Door #3).
- You can give electronically through Subsplash, using the instructions below.
 - * Go to our website: www.clcvalpo.org. Under the "Give" menu, select "Give Now." This will take you to the church's mail giving page.
 - * Enter the amount of your contribution. Use the slide bar next to the amount to select the frequency. You can choose "One Time," or you can choose another option to setup a recurring offering. Click "Next."
 - * You will be prompted to setup your account, or you can continue as a guest. (If you already have an account, use the icon at the top right of the screen to log in to your account.) You can use email (most people use this option), Apple, or Facebook to create your account.
 - * Follow the prompts to enter your contribution, then click the "Give Now" button.

The **Food Bank of Northwest Indiana**'s (FBNI) mission is "to provide food for hungry people in NW Indiana through a network of charities increasing public awareness and advocating solutions for the issues involved with hunger and acting as an info &referral source to the community".

FBNI is based in Merrillville and is affiliated with and meets the guidelines of Feeding America www.feedingamerica.org and distributes over 2 million pounds of goods/year through 90 network charities in NW Indiana.

Project Neighbors (454 College Ave.) is a Not-for-Profit organization in Valpo. By addressing issues of race, class and poverty,



Project Neighbors' goal is to build healthy families and neighborhoods, where diversity of all kinds is welcomed and cherished. Project Neighbors' accomplishments in Valparaiso include affordable housing at Caroline's Place and Neighbor's Place and Respite House, childcare and preschool at Hilltop House, community health centers in HealthLinc, and the region's only low-power, all-volunteer community radio station, WVLP, among other "risks-turned-rewards."
