Our State Executive Director, Dr. Wes Fowler, delivered such a powerful and encouraging word for us. Then, we got to meet nearly all of our State Convention staff. We then had a wonderful meal and time of fellowship, followed by helpful and practical breakouts. Finally, we closed with our business session. And we were done by 8:00. Why our churches would not want to come and be a part of this exciting time is beyond me. We really do need each other. We are better together. Encourage your church to attend next year. You won't be sorry.

I do want to bring attention to one of our business items however. We had a short fall in our income this year which put us behind on budget. Many of our churches tithe their income by giving a percentage to the Association. We are thankful for you. When a church's attendance is down, so is their income, and then so is ours.

Then, in addition, we had an unexpected and dramatic increase in some necessary areas. Most of your churches noticed a huge increase in your church insurance. We had the same increase as well. Also, utilities were way up with weather. On top of all that, our printer/copier went out right before the Annual meeting.

So, income was shorter while expenditures were up. What can we do? You may or may not know that at one time our DOM position was full-time. I am part-time now. In addition, I did not take a raise this year. Here at the office, we are cutting back on thermostat settings. We are cutting some programs we can either do away with or use cheaper version. We presented a bare-bones budget.

What I am asking our churches to do is this. First, if you are giving to the Association on a percentage basis, I am asking if you would consider raising that percentage. Some churches give a set amount instead of a percentage. That way it is not affected when attendance drops. If you give a set amount, please consider raising that amount. If your church does not give, please consider giving to your Association. We are here to assist you. Our Annual meeting our Missions Fair, and our VBS clinic with their break-out sessions are designed to help pastors and lay people by equipping them to do Kingdom work. Also, many of our churches work together doing missions. We encourage one another, pray for one another, and give ideas for ministry.

You are missing out if you are not a part. We would love to have you come, as we benefit from each other.


