On Friday evening of assembly, Bishop Laurie was joined by her family and recognized for her years of ministry with the synod. After serving as the Director for Evangelical Mission (2014-2018) Laurie served as the first woman bishop (2018-2024) for the Northwest Synod of Wisconsin.
