★ Suggested Song

- ★ Catechism for Young Children Question (for families with children elementary and under)
 - Q. 15. Who wrote the Bible?
 - A. 15. Chosen men who were guided by the Holy Spirit.
 - Q. 16. Who were our first parents?
 - A. 16. Adam and Eve.
 - Q. 17. What were our first parents made of?
 - A. 17. God made Adam's body out of the earth, and He made Eve from Adam's body.
- ★ Shorter Catechism Question (for families with children in *middle school & up*)
 - Q. 14. What is sin?
 - A. 14. Sin is disobeying or not conforming to God's law in any way.
- ★ Scripture Memory: 1 John 4:7-12
 - ★ "Beloved, let us love one another, for love is from God, and whoever loves has been born of God and knows God. Anyone who does not love does not know God, because God is love. In this the love of God was made manifest among us, that God sent his only Son into the world, so that we might live through him. In this is love, not that we have loved God but that he loved us and sent his Son to be the propitiation for our sins. Beloved, if God so loved us, we also ought to love one another. No one has ever seen God; if we love one another, God abides in us and his love is perfected in us."

DAILY DEVOTIONS (5 TOTAL)

Day 1

- ★ Reading: Romans 10:5-9
- ★ Questions: What is Paul contrasting in verses 5 &6? Why is this contrast significant?

 What would a person need to be able to do to 'bring Christ down' or 'bring Christ up' from the dead?

In verse 8, what does the righteousness that is by faith say? What does that mean to us?

★ End with prayer – pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 2

★ Reading: Romans 10:5-9

★ Questions: What does the phrase 'Jesus is Lord' mean?

What does it mean to believe in your heart? How are we to understand 'God raised him from the dead?'

Who is responsible for your salvation> Why is grasping this truth important for our understanding of assurance and perseverance?

★ End with prayer – pray that we will be faithful managers of our time, talent, and treasure.

Day 3

★ Reading: Romans 10:10

★ Questions: Can a person be a secret Christian? Why/why not?

How do the people you live and work with know of your faith?

What are some practical steps you can take to live out your faith?

★ End with prayer – pray for physical health and strength for ourselves, our family, and friends.

Day 4

★ Reading: Romans 10:11-13

★ Question: List the similarities between the quotation in verse 11 and verse 13.

List the differences between the two quotations.

Are the differences significant? Why/why not?

★ End with prayer – pray for the spiritual revival of the community and nation.

Day 5

★ Reading: Romans 10:11-13

★ Questions: Who does the Bible say will not be blessed if they call on the name of the Lord? How does this mesh with God's sovereign election?

What is evangelism? What role does the institutional church play in evangelism? What is your role?

★ End with prayer – pray for the effectiveness of the ministries of Bethel.
