



Weekly Discipleship Plan (*Week of August 10th*)

Shorter Catechism Question:

Q. 16. Did all mankind fall in Adam's first disobedience?

A. 16. Since the covenant was made not only for Adam but also for his natural descendants, all mankind sinned in him and fell with him in his first disobedience.

Scripture Memory: Exodus 20:1-2 *And God spoke all these words, saying, "I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt, out of the house of slavery."*

DAILY DEVOTIONS

Day 1

Reading: Genesis 14-15

Questions: How does Abram's interaction with Melchizedek (14:18-20) reveal God's provision?

What does God's vision to Abram (15:1-6) teach us about trusting in the Lord's timing?

How can you seek peace in conflicts like Abram did with Lot?

End with prayer: pray for the effectiveness of evangelism and discipleship.

Day 2

Reading: Genesis 16-17

Questions: What does Sarai and Abram's decision to have a child through Hagar reveal about their faith and struggles?

How does God's promise to change Abram and Sarai's names reflect His covenant purposes?

How can you better wait on God's timing instead of taking matters into your own hands?

End with prayer: pray for growth in love and compassion towards our neighbors.

Day 3

Reading: Genesis 18

Questions: What does Abraham's hospitality to the three visitors teach about serving others?

How does God's conversation with Abraham about Sodom reflect His justice and mercy?

What warnings does this passage provide about living in a society/community opposed to God and His commands?

End with prayer: pray for the Lord to renew your mind with His truth.

Day 4

Reading: Genesis 19-20

Questions: What do we learn about Lot's faith and character from his actions in Sodom?

How does God protect Sarah and His promise to Abraham despite Abraham's failure?

In what areas of your life do you need to trust God even when you've made mistakes in the past?

End with prayer: pray for personal renewal of body & spirit.

Day 5

Reading: Genesis 21

Questions: What does the birth of Isaac teach us about God's faithfulness to His promises?

How does Hagar's story highlight God's care for the rejected and vulnerable?

How can you show care for others who may feel forgotten or marginalized?

End with prayer: pray for the Lord to renew our minds with His truth.

Day 6

Reading: Genesis 22-23

Questions: What does God's command to sacrifice Isaac reveal about Abraham's faith?

How does Abraham's purchase of a burial site for Sarah demonstrate his trust in God's promises?

In what ways can you worship God through obedience in your daily life?

End with prayer: pray that we will be faithful managers of our time, talent, and treasure.

Day 7

Reading: Genesis 24

Questions: What can we learn from Rebekah's willingness to follow God's plan?

How does this passage demonstrate God's faithfulness to His promises to Abraham?

How can you seek God's guidance in your decision-making?

End with prayer: pray for physical health and strength for ourselves, our family, and friends.
