Psalm 46:1-7 ESV

Pastor: God is our refuge and strength, a very present help in trouble.

Westminster Confession of Faith

Chapter 21:2,3 Concerning Religious Worship and the Sabbath Day

We believe that religious worship is to be given to God, the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit, and to him alone, not to angels, saints, or to any other creature. Also, since the fall of mankind, worship cannot occur without a mediator, nor in the mediation of anyone other than Christ alone.

Prayer with thanksgiving is one part of religious worship and is required by God from all men. In order for prayer to be accepted, it must be made in the name of Jesus, by the help of the Spirit, according to His will, with understanding, reverence, humility, fervor, faith, love, and perseverance, and, if vocal, in a known tongue.
