The Westminster Confession of Faith Concerning the Holy Spirit See WCF 1.5, 1.6, 2.3, 18.2, and 19.7

The Holy Spirit is the third person of the Godhead, eternally proceeding from the Father and the Son. It is the inward work of the Holy Spirit, bearing witness by and with the Word in our Hearts, that subdues and enables the will of man to do freely and cheerfully, the will of God, as revealed in the law. It is this inward illumination of the Spirit of God that is necessary for the saving understanding of such things as are revealed to the Word. The Spirit also gives testimony to our adoption, by witnessing to our spirits that we are children of God.
