Psalm 46

Our Refuge in Trouble

What does it mean for God to be our refuge and strength? Can you recall a time when you personally experienced God's protection during a difficult season?

Unshakeable Confidence

Verses 2–3 describe chaos in the world, yet the psalmist declares, “We will not fear.” How can we cultivate fearless faith even when our circumstances feel unstable?

The River of Peace

Verse 4 speaks of a river that brings joy to the city of God. What might this river symbolize, and how can we experience that joy and peace in our own lives?

God in the Midst

Verse 5 says, “God is within her, she will not fall.” How does God’s presence give us strength when we feel weak or uncertain?

Be Still and Know

Verse 10 says, “Be still, and know that I am God.” Why is stillness important in our spiritual life, and how can we create space to be still before Him?

Prayer Prompt:

Lord, in a world full of noise and chaos, help me to pause, be still, and remember that You are God. Be my refuge, my strength, and my peace today.
