Following Jesus at a Cost

Levi left behind a lucrative career to follow Jesus. What are some things in your life that might be hard to walk away from, and how might those things be holding you back from full surrender?

Who's at Your Table?

Levi immediately invited his friends—many of whom were considered outsiders—to meet Jesus. Who in your life are you setting the table for? Are there people you've unintentionally excluded?

The Lie of "Not Ready"

The sermon debunks the lie that we must have all the answers before sharing Jesus with others. What fears or insecurities keep you from sharing your faith? How can we support each other in stepping out anyway?

Jesus vs. the Pharisees

Jesus met people where they were, while the Pharisees expected people to "clean up" before being accepted. In what ways do we (even unintentionally) adopt a Pharisee mindset in how we view or treat others?

Your Everyday Mission Field

The sermon reminds us it's no accident where we work, live, or go to school. How might you begin to see your everyday environments as opportunities to "set the table" for others to meet Jesus?

Prayer Prompt:

Jesus, thank You for seeing me even when I was far from You. Thank You for inviting me to Your table. Give me a heart like Levi's—a heart that surrenders fully, invites boldly, and trusts deeply that You will show up when I make room for You. Open my eyes to the people around me who need Your hope. Help me not to wait, not to be intimidated, but to step out in faith and love. Let my life declare that people matter. Amen.
