We Are Epic Life: Irresistible Community

Light in the Darkness

Jesus says in Matthew 5:14–16 that we are the light of the world. What does it practically look like for your life to “shine before others” this week? Where do you feel God asking you to stand out?

Sharing More Than Words

1 Thessalonians 2:8 says the early church shared not only the gospel but their very lives. Who in your life right now needs more than just your words—they need your presence, your time, or your care?

Fellowship that Costs Something

The sermon explained the difference between fun and biblical fellowship—that true fellowship will cost us something. What sacrifices have you seen or experienced in genuine Christian community? How might God be inviting you to give of yourself in this way?

The Power of Prayer Together

We heard how prayer deepened lifelong friendships in ways nothing else ever had. Why do you think praying with others feels so vulnerable? How could our group grow stronger by praying more openly and consistently together?

Radical Generosity in Action

Acts 2 describes believers selling possessions and giving to anyone in need. While we may not sell land, what are some modern ways we can live out radical generosity in our families, workplaces, and neighborhoods?

Evidence of an Irresistible Community

What do you think it was about the early church’s way of life that made their community so attractive to outsiders? How can our church reflect those same qualities today?

Lord, thank You for making us a new creation in Christ and calling us to be Your ambassadors. Help us to live as an irresistible community—devoted to Your Word, to fellowship, to sharing meals, and to prayer.
