Living with Expectancy

How does having an “expectant faith” change the way we approach everyday life and the opportunities God places before us?

Recognizing the Battle

Paul reminds us in Ephesians 6 that we are in a spiritual war. Is that something you typically think about or consider? What do you think is at stake when we choose to live oblivious to the reality that we are in a spiritual war? Have you ever allowed fear, doubt, and or insecurity to disarm you in this fight?

Lies vs. Truth

2 Corinthians 10:5 says we must take every thought captive and make it obedient to Christ. What are some common lies you’ve believed about yourself, and how can God’s Word replace them with truth? What is a truth that you need to begin claiming over your life?

“Do You Want to Be Healed?”

Jesus asked the paralyzed man at Bethesda if he wanted to be well. Why do you think acknowledging our brokenness is such a crucial step in receiving healing?

Walking in Freedom

Jesus told the healed man to “Get up, pick up your mat, and walk.” What does it look like for you personally to “get up and walk” in the freedom Christ has already given you?

Lord, thank You for calling us to live with expectant faith. Help us recognize the battles we face, replace lies with Your truth, and embrace the healing and freedom You offer. Give us courage to “get up and walk” each day, trusting that You have a plan and purpose for our lives.
